How it Works

1. **Download the App:** Get the Worcestershire On Demand app from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store.
2. **Book a Journey:** Enter your pick-up and drop-off points to request a ride.
3. **Find Your Stop:** The app will direct you to a designated “virtual bus stop” near your location.
4. **Share the Ride:** The service matches your journey with other passengers heading in a similar direction, creating an efficient, shared ride.
